



## 2022 RTO obligations checklist

Keep track of key dates for your training provider this year

	Check that ASQA can contact you in 2022	
ASAP	<ul> <li>Do you know your asqanet login details? If you can't log in to <u>asqanet.asqa.gov.au</u>, email <u>enquiries@asqa.gov.au</u>.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Make sure your Chief Executive Officer's email address is up to date at <u>asqanet.asqa.gov.au</u>.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Provide a mobile phone number for your Chief Executive Officer so you can receive SMS reminders for urgent matters.</li> </ul>	
) — ) 28 FEB 2022 сов	Report your RTO's Total VET Activity AVETMISS data for 2021 to NCVER— every RTO has to report, even if no training was provided. <u>Check your requirements</u> .	
) —) 31 MAR 2022 сов	Submit your 2022 declaration on compliance with the <i>Standards for Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) 2015.</i> Note: Your CEO will receive an email with the submission link in February.	
) —) 30 JUN 2022 сов	Submit your 2021 quality indicator data to <u>qidata@asqa.gov.au</u> . <u>Check your requirements</u> .	
) —) 31 JULY 2022 сов	Pay ASQA your annual registration charge.	
12 MONTHS CLOSE 90 DAYS BEFORE	Keep your registration up to date by checking when it expires at <u>asqanet.asqa.gov.</u> <u>au</u> or <u>training.gov.au</u> .	
	Renewal applications open 12 months prior to registration expiry and close 90 days before expiry. Get in early to avoid delays.
