- 1 Focus on student-centred learning** – this improves engagement, satisfaction and supports students to develop real-world, industry relevant competencies.



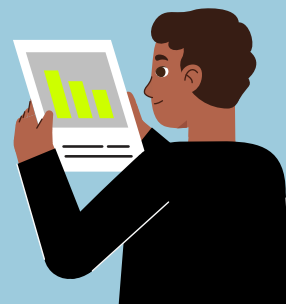
- 2 Ensure students are treated fairly**, are properly informed and supported throughout their training.



- 3 Employ qualified and skilled staff** who are committed to ongoing professional development.



- 4 Embed a culture of continuous improvement** by regularly reviewing your systems, practices and performance.
