I am writing to let you know that ASQA intends on cancelling the following qualification(s) and/or statement(s) of attainment issued to you by ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd trading as Nationwide Academy (**the provider**) (see Annexure A for qualifications and statements of attainment).

Before we make our final decision, you have an opportunity to respond to us in writing and provide details why this decision should not be made. Your response must be submitted by **11:59 PM (AEDT) on 6 October 2026**.

Decision we intend to make

ASQA intends to make the following decision:

- cancel, under s56(1)(a) and s56(1)(d) of the *National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011* (the NVR Act) the qualification(s) and/or statement(s) of attainment issued to you by ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd on the basis that the Regulator is satisfied on reasonable grounds that:
 - ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd did not provide, or arrange for another person to provide, all or part of the assessment necessary for you to achieve the learning outcomes or competencies required for the qualification or the units of competencies specified in the statement of attainment
 - it is appropriate, in all the circumstance, because of action ASQA has taken in relation to ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd.

Our reasons for the above decision are outlined in the attached Statement of Reasons and our Qualification Integrity Report.

Statement of Reasons

Decision	1. Give, under s57(1)(b)(ii) of the <i>National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011</i> (NVR Act), notice of ASQA's intent to cancel, under s56(1)(a) and s56(1)(d) of the NVR Act, the qualification(s) and/or statement(s) of attainment issued to you by ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd during the period 5 September 2023 to 13 July 2026 on the basis that the Regulator is satisfied on reasonable grounds that: a) ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd did not provide, or arrange for another person to provide, all or part of the assessment necessary for you to achieve the learning outcomes or competencies required for the qualification(s) and/or the unit(s) of competency specified in the statement(s) of attainment; and b) it is appropriate, in all the circumstances, because of action ASQA has taken in relation to ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd. 2. Give a period of 28 days to respond to the notice of intent.

Reasons for decision
3. This statement sets out the reasons for the decision I have made as detailed above. 4. I am satisfied on reasonable grounds that: a. ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd did not provide, or arrange for another person to provide, all or part of the assessment necessary for you to achieve the learning outcomes or competencies required for your VET courses identified above. b. It is appropriate, in all the circumstances, because of action ASQA has taken in relation to ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd, namely cancelling the registration of the provider Materials relied upon 5. In making its decision, ASQA has considered: a. the Qualification Integrity Report dated 10 August 2026

- b. ASQA's decision to cancel the registration of ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd.

Findings

6. ASQA conducted a compliance audit in relation to ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd. This audit identified serious and systemic non-compliance with the provider's regulatory obligations that had the impact that students did not receive training that would have equipped them with the skills and competencies required by the training package. The compliance audit also identified that ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd issued qualifications to students without conducting adequate assessment to ensure students had the required skills and competencies as required by the training package. On this basis, ASQA took action to cancel ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd's registration.
7. As detailed in the Qualification Integrity Report, ASQA is satisfied that the provider did not provide adequate training and assessment to students on the basis of the following findings. The provider did not:
 - a. implement training and assessment strategies and practices consistent with the requirements of the relevant training packages
 - b. implement an assessment system, including for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), that ensured assessment complied with the requirements of the relevant training packages and the Principles of Assessment and Rules of Evidence
 - c. demonstrate that it had access to appropriately qualified trainers and assessors to deliver and assess the training products prior to issuing qualifications or statements of attainment
 - d. operate with integrity and maintain accountability for the delivery of quality services
 - e. demonstrate a commitment or capability to deliver quality vocational education and training.
8. As detailed in the Qualification Integrity Report, ASQA is satisfied that the provider did not provide adequate training and assessment to students during the period 5 September 2023 to 13 July 2026 (the relevant period). ASQA is satisfied this is the relevant period because:
 - a. According to information provided by ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd, consistent with ASIC Current & Historical Company Extracts for the provider, the Owner/RTO Manager during the time of the compliance investigation, Mr Abdulkadir Abdelkerim, purchased 100% of shares in the company on 1 November 2023.
 - b. However, 5 September 2023 is the earliest unit completion date in the delivery data submitted by ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd and the evidence in the Qualification Integrity Report establishes the purported assessor was not employed by the provider at that time.
 - c. In addition, student feedback received by ASQA during the compliance audit included evidence of ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd backdating Student Management System and delivery data to make it appear that training and assessment was completed earlier than it was.
 - d. ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd's RTO registration was cancelled effective 13 July 2026, meaning the provider could no longer issue qualifications from this date.
9. Your qualification(s) and/or statement(s) of attainment were issued during the relevant period.

Considerations relevant to the decision

10. The NVR Act is protective in nature, and maintaining public confidence in the integrity of VET qualifications and statements of attainment is critical to meeting that protective object. There is a public interest in ensuring that people who hold a VET qualification or statement of attainment have been properly trained, that there is a minimum standard required to receive a particular qualification, that there is a rigorous assessment process and that there is consistency in those standards across providers.
11. Where students have not been properly trained and assessed, it is in the public interest for issued qualifications and statements of attainment to be cancelled so that consumers, employers and others can safely rely on VET qualifications.
12. Having regard to the findings set out above, I am satisfied it is appropriate to provide you with a notice of intent to cancel the qualification(s) and/or statement(s) issued to you by ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd during the period 5 September 2023 to 13 July 2026 on the basis that ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd did not provide or arrange for another person to provide all or part of the assessment necessary during that period for you to achieve the learning outcomes or competencies required for the qualifications and units of competency (see Annexure A for Qualifications and Statements of Attainment).
13. I am also satisfied that it is appropriate in all the circumstances because of the action, including the reasons for that action, the Regulator took in cancelling the registration of ACG Global Australasia Pty Ltd.
14. The nature of the issues and impact of the intended decision are serious in nature and require a reasonable period within which to respond. In balancing this against the public interest described above, I have decided a 28-day period to respond to this notice of intent is appropriate.
